Briefing Session on

Import of beef, Pork and Mutton from European Union Member States

Currently, importers can make use of the European Union (EU) document, i.e. Export Certificate coupled with permission issued by Center for Food Safety (CFS) to import red meat (beef, pork and mutton) from animals born, raised, slaughtered, processed and packed in different eligible EU member states. Recently, the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department and the EU agreed to modify end extend the Export Certificate to serve as a dual purpose document, i.e. an "Export Declaration" for animals which were slaughtered, processed and packed in different eligible EU member states whereas a "Health Certificate" is for the animals which were slaughtered, processed and packed in the same eligible EU member state.
